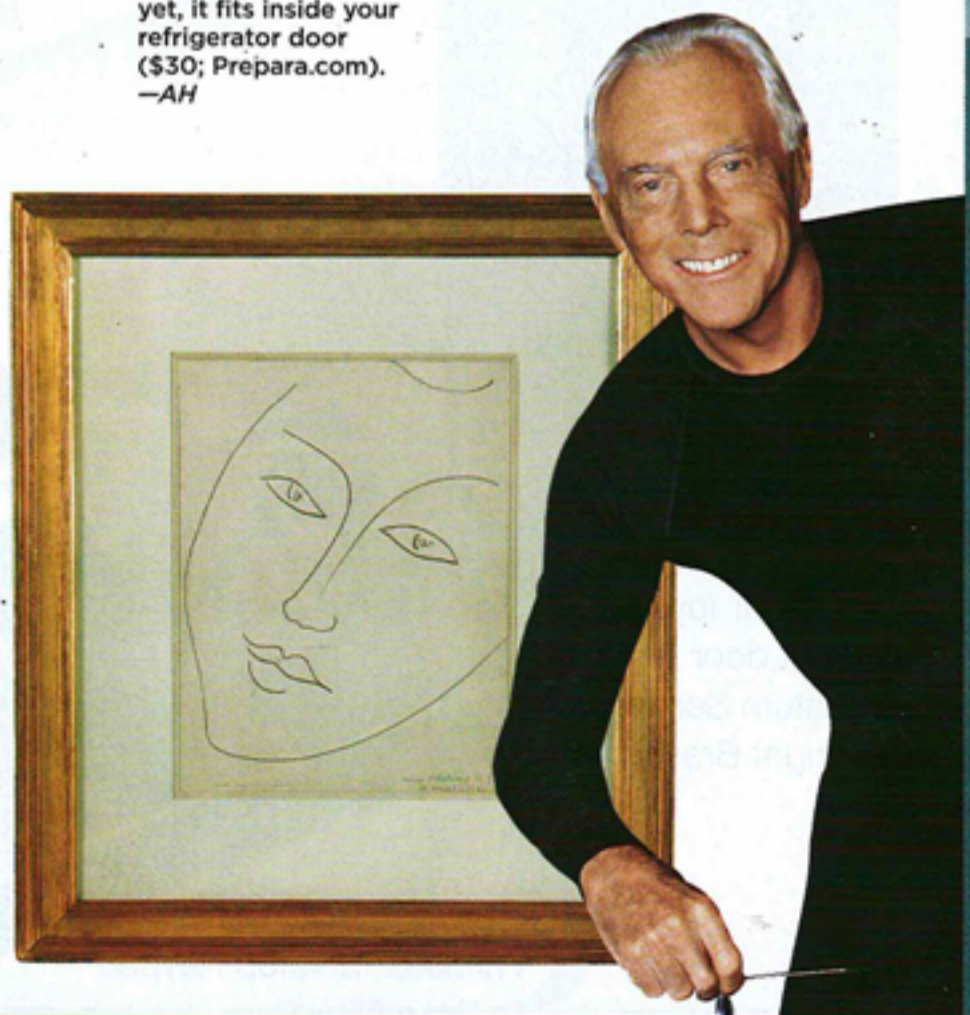
METRIC TONS OF
